IT'S YOUR MOVE HAS OFFICIALLY STARTED!

Support YOUR after school program-Even if you don't have kids in the program.

The ROCK Center for Youth Development is kicking off your Grounded Program Fundraiser & It's YOUR Move!

The game is on! This fundraiser is a competition between our three locations, Northeast Middle School, Jefferson Middle School and The ROCK Underground at GMCC. Each month, during the school year The ROCK will announce a different fundraiser and the Grounded location with the most participants or \$\$ raised each month will receive an afternoon of free cotton candy, sno-cones or popcorn – the location's choice!

Watch the game board in the monthly newsletter to see how your location is doing! The ROCK Grounded program has seen incredible growth in the past 2 years and we need you to financially help keep it going. We've come up with some fun, easy ways for you to help and it's YOUR move!

OCTOBER – BECOME A ROCK STAR! Sign up for regular monthly donations and support YOUR after school program all year long. We make it easy! Just sign up for a monthly deduction from your debit or credit card and we'll take care of the rest! The location which has the most people sign up for a monthly donation will win the first month of our competition!

NOVEMBER – AMAZONSMILE: AmazonSmile is a simple and automatic way for you to support The ROCK every time you shop, at no cost to you. When you shop at smile amazon.com, you'll find the exact same low prices, vast selection and convenient shopping experience as Amazon.com, with the added bonus that Amazon will donate a portion of the purchase price to The ROCK. If you shop at Amazon, switch over to smile.amazon.com, choose "Reaching our Community Kids" as your charity and AmazonSmile will donate a percentage of your total order to The ROCK! (Gift-giving season is upon us!) You can email a screen print to rockon@therockc4yd.org or bring it in to your location to show that you're signed up with AmazonSmile and it will count towards the number of people signed up.

> DECEMBER – SCRIP: What is Scrip Fundraising? Scrip is fundraising while you shop. Here's how it works: you buy a scrip gift card through The ROCK's Scrip program. You pay the full face value, but The ROCK will earn an immediate rebate percentage that's typically between 3% and

15% depending on the retailer. Then you use that gift card on normal purchases or give as gifts! You're not spending extra money, and there's no selling involved—you're just earning for The ROCK. The location with the most Scrip orders by Dec. 9th (Cards back by the 15th) wins "It's YOUR Move" for the month of December. (See a staff member at the program for scrip order forms)

JANUARY – PENNY WARS: We'll be collecting your change for The ROCK Grounded Program. Look for the jar at each location and just drop in your pocket change. The location with the most \$\$ at the end of January wins "It's YOUR Move"!

FEBRUARY – GOFUNDME CAMPAIGN: We will have a GoFundMe campaign to raise money strictly for snacks for our after school programs. The location with the most \$\$ raised will win for the month of February!

MARCH - POP CAN FUNDRAISER: Get rid of your pop cans by donating them this month to The ROCK! The location with the most \$\$ raised will take over the month of March!

APRIL – KROGER REWARDS: If you shop at Kroger, pick up a Community Rewards card then go online to https://www.kroger.com/account/ enrollCommunityRewardsNow and pick "Reaching Our Community Kids" as your charity. OR, if you don't shop Kroger that often, you can always give The ROCK's phone number at the checkout and make your donation that way. The ROCK receives a percentage of everything you buy! April is also the time to renew your Kroger Community Rewards card if you already have one. So be sure to renew during this time. Bring a receipt showing a donation was made to The ROCK to the after school location your teen attends. The location with the most receipts (just receipts, not dollar amount) wins "It's YOUR Move" for the month of April.

MAY - RESTAURANT FUNDRAISER: Let's end the year by having dinner together. Watch for details on this fundraiser.


